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Settlement Background

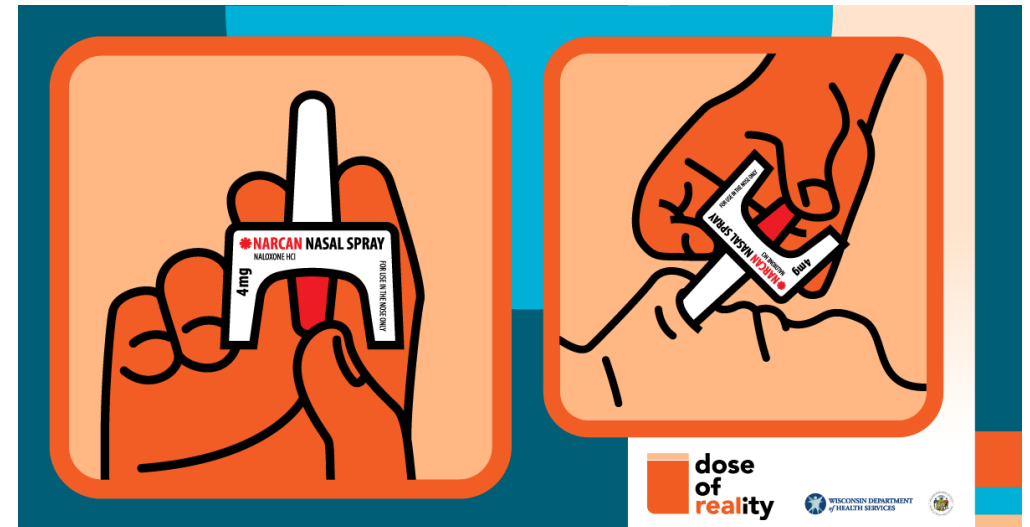
- **30%** of settlement proceeds allocated to DHS
- **70%** of settlement proceeds are provided to local governments that were party to the litigation
- Annual plan submitted to Joint Committee on Finance (JCF) by April 1
- Quarterly report submitted to JCF
(March, June, September, December)

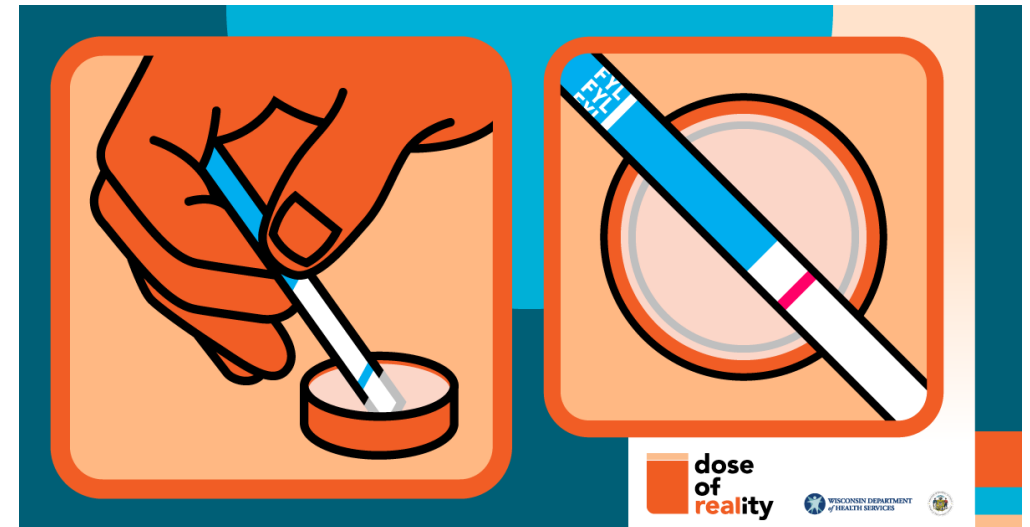
Expand Narcan® Direct

- \$3 million to expand and broaden
- \$750,000 to law enforcement agencies
- \$500,000 to community agencies
- \$980,000 for Public Health Vending Machines (PHVM)
- \$570,000 EMS Leave Behind Programs



Fentanyl Test Strips

- \$2 million to establish and distribute
- \$300,000 to Opioid Treatment Programs
- \$300,000 law enforcement agencies
- \$1.1 million PHVM
- \$300,000 EMS Leave Behind Programs



Public Health Vending Machines (PHVMs)

- Reduce overdose and overdose death
- Low barrier access to free supplies
- Reach and engage disproportionately impacted communities
- Avoid and reduce costs
- Reduce stigma

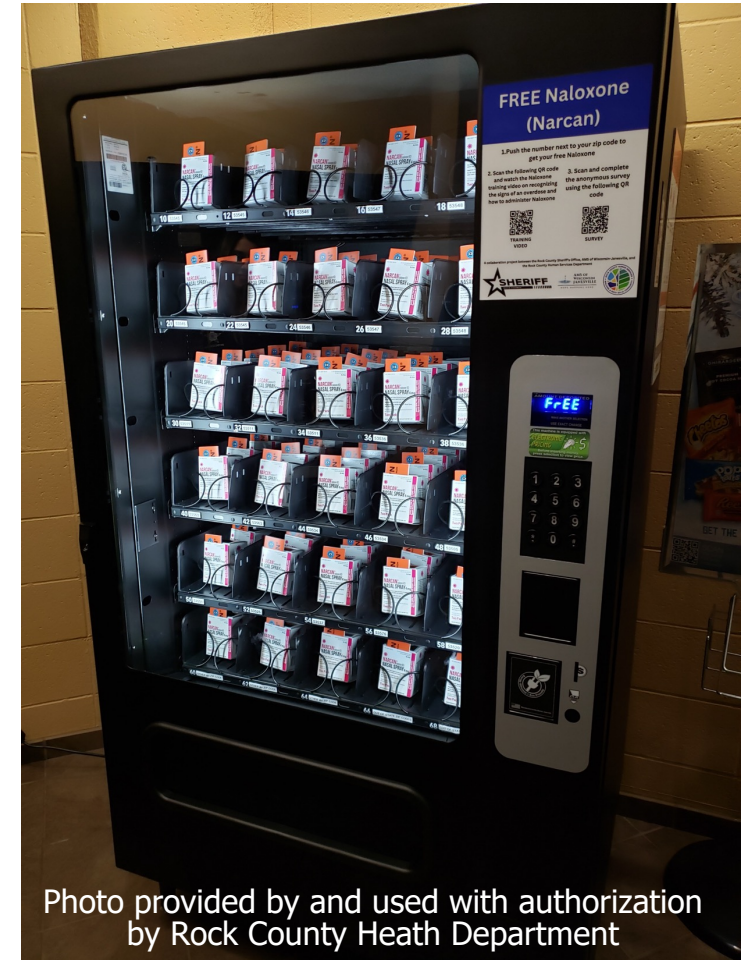

EMS Leave Behind Programs

- Focus on people with the highest overdose risk
- Provides overdose prevention materials to overdose survivor and/or their social network (family, friends, partner, roommates, etc.)



Capital Projects

- \$10 million allocated to DHS
- \$4.91 million to Arbor Place, Menomonie
- \$4.91 million to Meta House, Milwaukee
- \$183,278 to Lighthouse Recovery Community Center, Manitowoc

Tribal Nations

- \$6 million allocated to DHS
- Local problems require local solutions
- All tribes applied & receive funds
- Strategies across prevention, harm reduction, treatment, and recovery



Central Alert System

- \$500,000 allocated to DHS
- Creating a near real-time overdose surveillance and alert system
- WiSOARR – Wisconsin Suspected Overdose Alerts for Rapid Response



K-12 Prevention

- \$250,000 allocated to DHS
- Agreement with DPI to administer funds
 - Grant application process
 - Programming for 2023-2024 school year
 - 23 districts awarded funds



Medication-Assisted Treatment

- \$2 million allocated to DHS to increase service
- Wisconsin Society of Addiction Medicine telemedicine project
- Mobile Opioid Treatment Provider Units
 - 4 units serving Rock County, Black River Falls, Shawano, and Delavan

Room & Board Costs

- \$2.5 million allocated to DHS
- Fund Room & Board costs for Medicaid recipients who receive residential substance use disorder treatment services
- 49 tribal nations & counties funded
- 1,300+ individuals able to access services

Law Enforcement Agencies

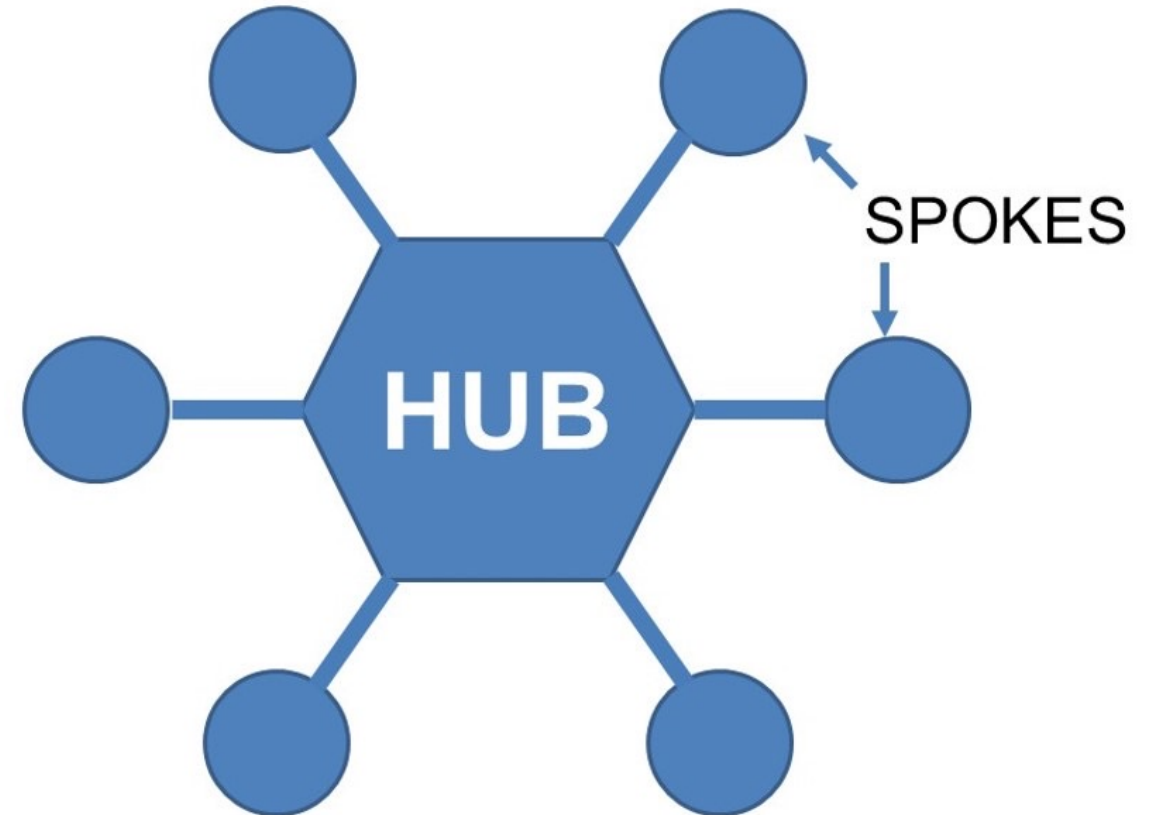
- \$3 million allocated to DHS
- Medication-assisted treatment education & training
- Community drug disposal programs
- Pre-arrest or pre-arraignment deflection programs
- Treatment in jails

Statewide Prevention

- \$750,000 allocated to DHS for after-school opioid prevention programs who use law enforcement partnerships
- Awarded to Boys & Girls Club Fox Valley, Inc., which represents 26 Clubs in Wisconsin
- SMART Moves program

Hub & Spoke

- \$1 million allocated to DHS to expand the Hub & Spoke Health Home Project
- \$500,000 to Vin Baker Recovery in Milwaukee



2023 Plan & Progress on Settlement Funds

2023 Plan

- \$8 million
- Public input survey
 - Over 4,000 participants
 - Ranked strategies provided during 2022 process
- Support across the continuum of care

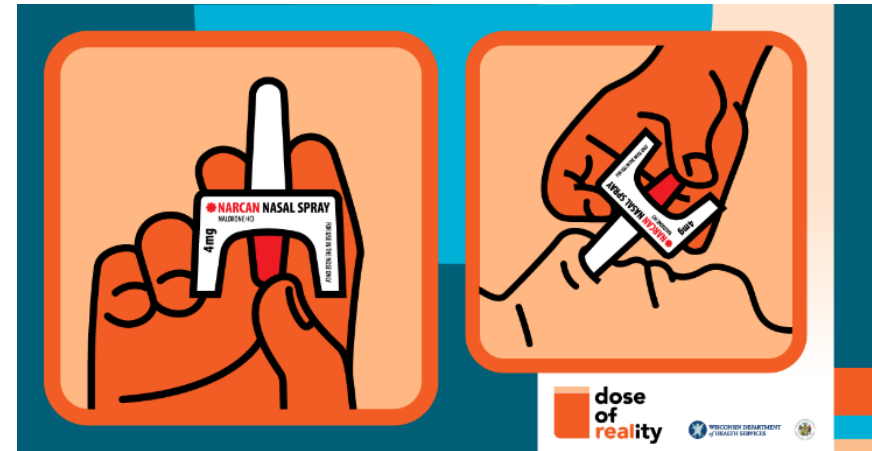

Narcan® & Fentanyl Test Strips

- \$2.9 million allocated to DHS
 - Community distribution, law enforcement, EMS



Other Projects

- **Room & Board Costs:** \$2.5 million
- **Medication Assisted Treatment:** \$2 million
- **Substance Use Disorder Treatment Platform:** \$300,000 to collect and maintain information on treatment providers.
- **Surgical Collaborative of Wisconsin:** \$300,000 for training on practices to reduce substance misuse.
