WC JAIL PROGRAMS

2022 - 2023

- Human Services Case Manager/ SUD Counselor housed in Jail
- Vivitrol Program through partnerships with DOJ, Health Unit, and outside medical providers
- Partnered with Solutions Peer Response Team to add Recovery Coaches
 - Meet with people while in jail and follow upon release

2024

- STAR Program
 - Full pod within jail focused on recovery
 - Each participant applies to the program
 - Participants must attend 4 recovery groups each week
 - Vivitrol available for those interested
 - Paired with a recovery coach to help connect to recovery community
 - Service navigation

399 Individuals served by recovery coaches in the Jail
